


Pitney Bowes Parcel Shipping Index


2019 Parcel Shipping Volume

China, the US, and Japan continue to lead parcel shipping volume in 2019, accounting for 84% of global parcel volume.






The UK and Germany followed with 3.8 bn and 3.7bn respectively.







2019 Per Capita Shipping

Global per capita shipping almost tripled over the last six years, reaching 27 parcels shipped per person (pp), up from 10 parcels pp in 2013.
