

Parcel volume growth in Australia from 2014-2018.


Global 2018 Parcel Shipping Volume

China, the US, and Japan continue to lead parcel shipping volume in 2018, accounting for 83% of global parcel volume.











Global per capita shipping has nearly doubled over the last four years, reaching 23 parcels shipped pp, up from 12 parcels pp in 2014.
