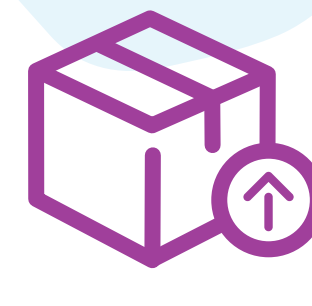

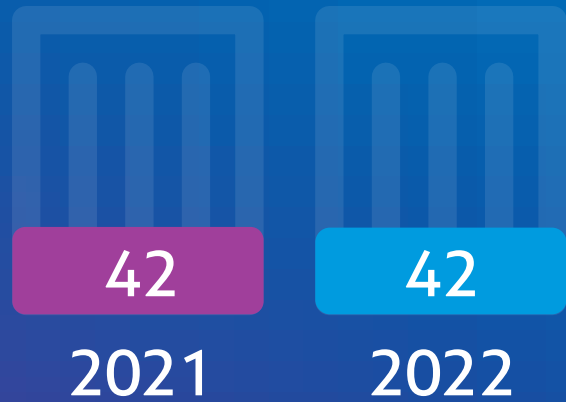
Number of parcels per second



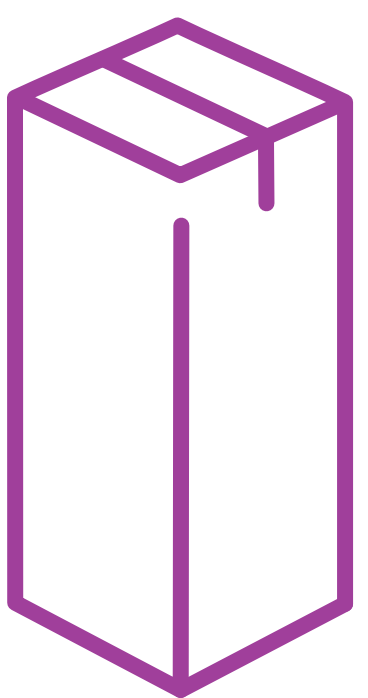
Number of parcels per day

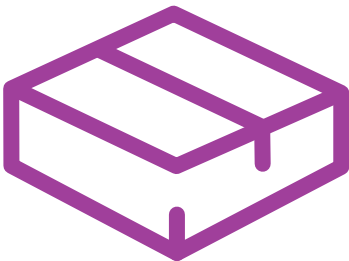

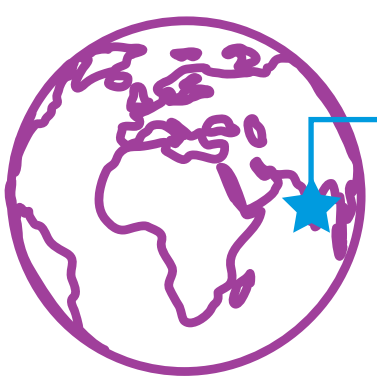

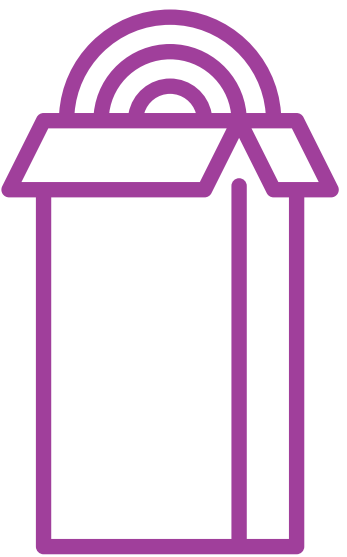

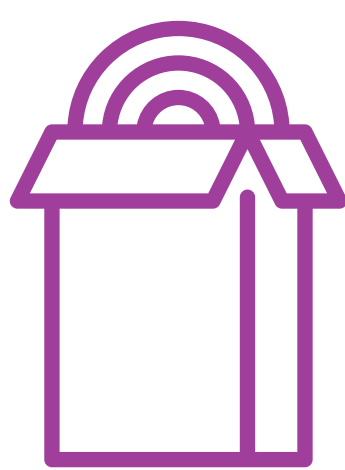

2022 Revenue Per Parcel

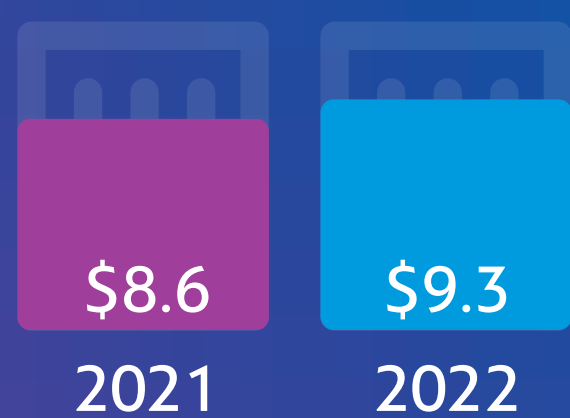
Globally, the revenue per parcel was **\$3.02** in 2022
