




2018 Parcel Shipping Volume

China, the US, and Japan continue to lead parcel shipping volume in 2018, accounting for 83% of global parcel volume















2018 Parcel Shipping Revenue

The **US** ranked highest, generating 38% of the total revenue of the 13 countries or \$119bn





2018 Per Capita Shipping

Global per capita shipping has nearly doubled over the last four years, reaching 23 parcels shipped per person (pp), up from 12 parcels pp in 2014
