

**CONTRACT AMENDMENT/ CHANGE ORDER No. 16
NEW JERSEY STATE TERM BLANKET P.O. 41258
T0200 - Mailroom Equipment, Accessories, Supplies & Maintenance**

This Contract Amendment (Amendment) is entered into by and between Pitney Bowes Inc., whose address is 27 Waterview Dr., Shelton, CT 06484 (the "Contractor"), and the State of New Jersey, Department of the Treasury, Division of Purchase and Property ("Division"), whose address is 33 West State Street, Trenton, NJ 08625, on behalf of the State of New Jersey and its Cooperative Purchasing Program participants, (the Division is collectively referred to as the "State."), and is intended to amend the above-referenced Blanket P.O. ("Contract") between the Contractor and the State as set forth below:

WHEREAS, the Parties have previously entered into a written agreement for Contractor to mailroom equipment, supplies, and maintenance to the State of New Jersey and its Cooperative Purchasing Program participants; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Bid Solicitation Section 5.2, Contract Term and Extension Option, the Contract's term shall be for three (3) year period, and may be extended up to three (3) years with no single extension exceeding one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Bid Solicitation Section 5.3, Contract Transition, the Contract's term may be extended up to an additional one hundred eighty (180) days if a new contract has not been awarded prior to the expiration of this Contract; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Bid Solicitation Section 5.4, Contract Amendment, and Section 5.14 of the New Jersey State Standard Terms and Conditions, the Parties are empowered to amend or alter the Contract by written and signed agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Contract is set to expire on April 14, 2024, and no new contract has been awarded to replace the existing Contract; and

WHEREAS, the State seeks to modify Bid Solicitation Section 5.3 to permit transition to extend up to one (1) year under the same terms, conditions and pricing, in order to provide the State with continuity of services while it works to complete the procurement and transition to a fully operational new contract.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the parties to this Agreement state and agree as follows:

1. Section 5.3 of the Contract is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

5.3 Contract Transition

In the event that a new Contract has not been awarded prior to this Contract expiration date, including any extensions exercised, and the State exercises this Contract transition, the Contractor shall continue this Contract under the same terms, conditions and pricing until a new Contract can be completely operational. At no time shall this transition period extend more than **one (1) year** beyond the expiration date of this Contract, including any extensions exercised.

2. The work shall be performed pursuant to the existing price lines.

3. Terms and Conditions - The parties agree to be bound by all other requirements, terms and conditions of the Bid Solicitation, not otherwise modified by this Amendment for the period of the Contract.
4. Execution of Amendment - The parties hereto agree that this Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each original signed page to become part of the original document.
