Notification to field service about the availability of the first Service Pack release to address issues in the v7.02 Business Manager Update.

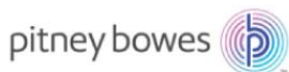
Summary of Enhancements:

- Fix for Business Manager Account import with format 'Business Manager' to correctly toggle Active/Inactive flags with DMs.
- Fix for MNScheduler to have multiple retries connecting to SQL after a reboot. Previously it was failing a connection and though running, would not schedule any further tasks.
- Added some more detail to logging that will show in if MNScheduler has any additional issues.
- Corrected account search issues seen with DMs that we saw when testing the active/inactive.
- Change for CCF Summary report, corrected for when all carriers are selected
- Change for CCF Summary report when selecting individual carriers
- Corrected DM Weight break report

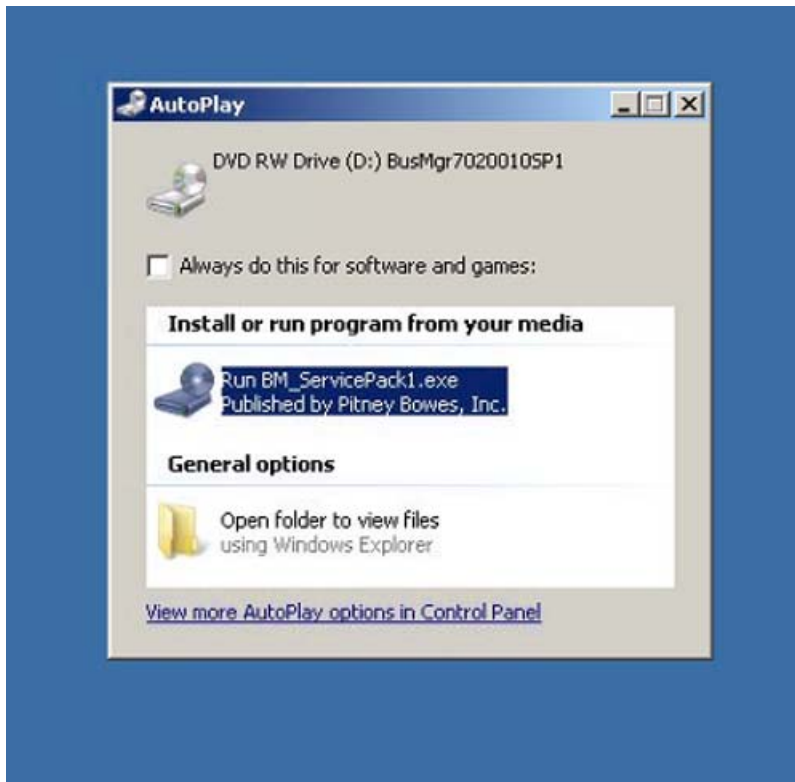
Actions:

Load as soon as possible on top of Business Manager 7.02 to keep system up to date. Installer will take approximately 6 minutes once installing.

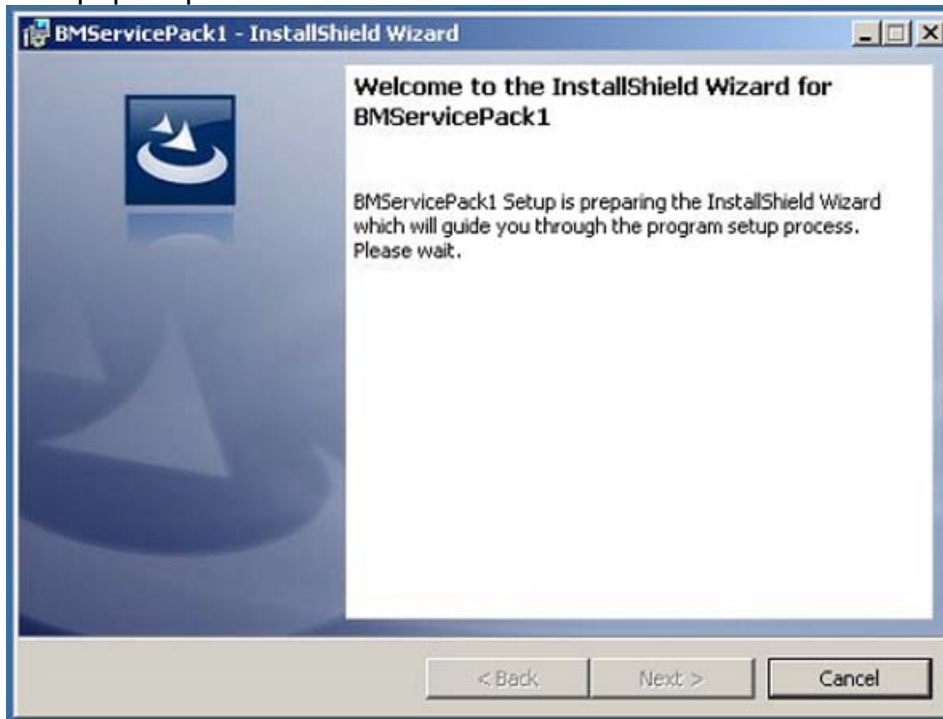
- Stop DM Service

- Select BM_ServicePack1.exe to run.

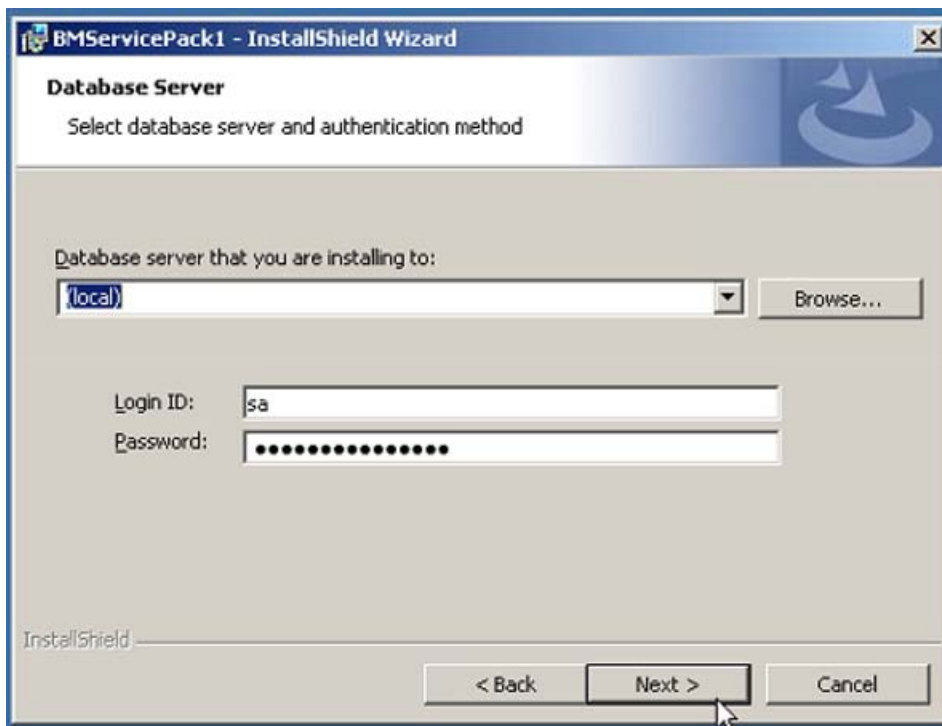
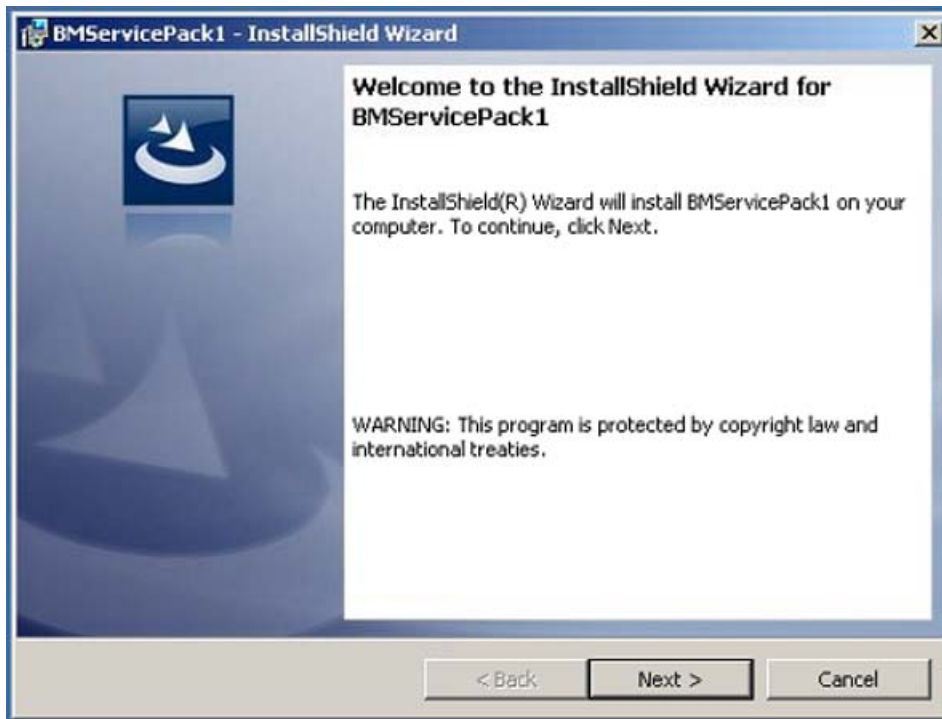


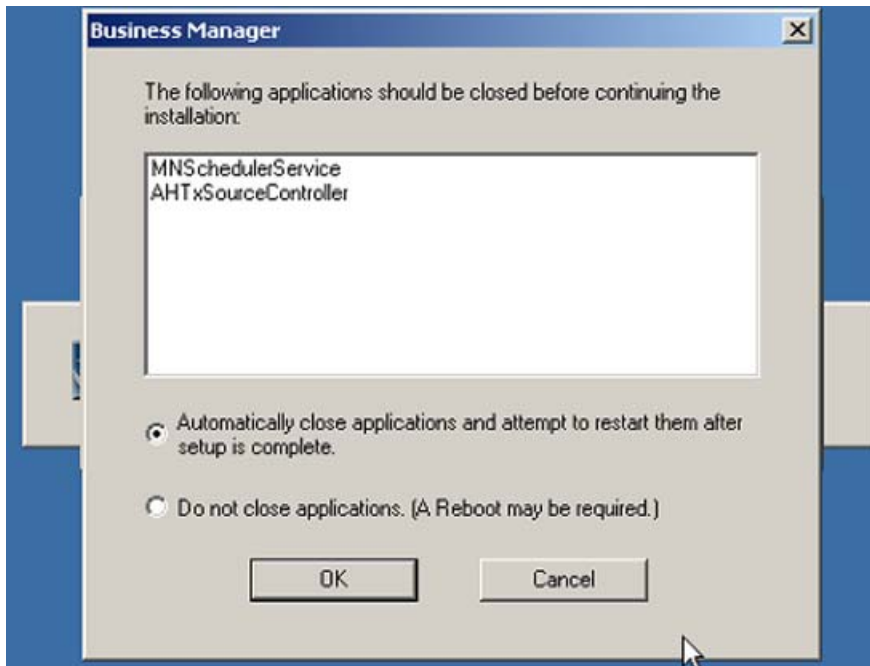
