- 142,646,25 addresses in total:
 - ❖ 100,590 new addresses
 - ❖ 47,150 retired addresses
- 654,461 extra addresses populated with Parcel IDs not present in raw G-NAF data (5%).
- 20,719 addresses populated with updated Postcodes based on Australia Post definitions.
- 40,300 addresses populated with updated Locality names based on agreed suburb definitions.
- All addresses populated with SA1 and AREA TYPE codes.
- All addresses now populated with SA1, Meshblock and Category values for the 2016 Census.
