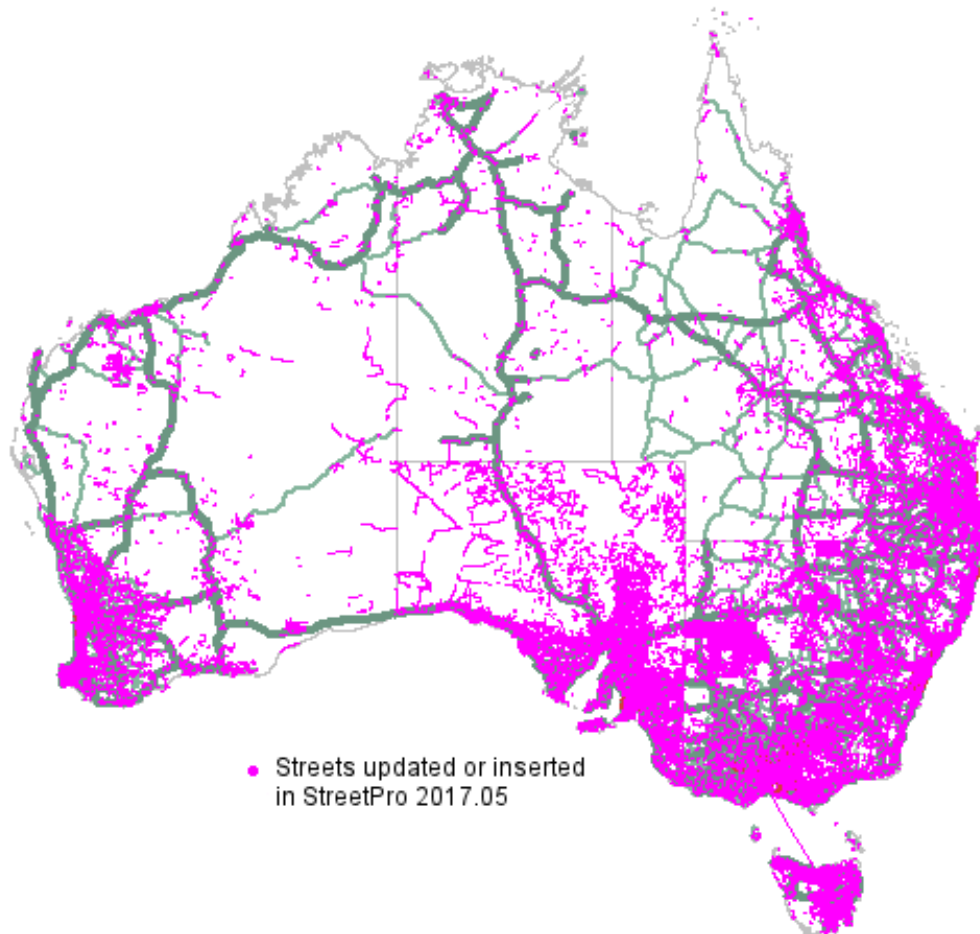
## Introduction

The 2017.05 release is a major quarterly update. StreetPro Australia is now produced four times a year: in March, June, September and December. Pitney Bowes will be in contact with users in the coming quarter to establish individual requirements for quarterly updates.

The StreetPro Australia 2017.05 release incorporates updates to all states, but streets updates are focused in ACT, NSW, NT, VIC, WA and QLD. Updated layers for this release include streets, point features and land use.

This release notes document provides detail on the major enhancements made in the 2017.05 release, plus the planned enhancements for future releases.

## Streets updates (AUS\_ST)



Nationally, there have been more than one million updated or inserted road segments for this release. These updates include name changes, addressing updates or other changes to attribution or geometry.

## Context layer updates

- Update and refinement of micodes, to bring categorization into alignment with the World Premium Points of Interest product:
