ICP Authentication Page Customization

Summary

This document describes how to customize EngageOne Connect's ICP Authentication Page on a Communication level

Use Case

The User wants to send a communication with ICP, and to modify the default ICP Authentication page with logo/text etc. Examples can be branding the authentication page with logo, colors or translating the authentication page to a different language

Technical description:

The customization is done by applying a new CSS for the authentication page.

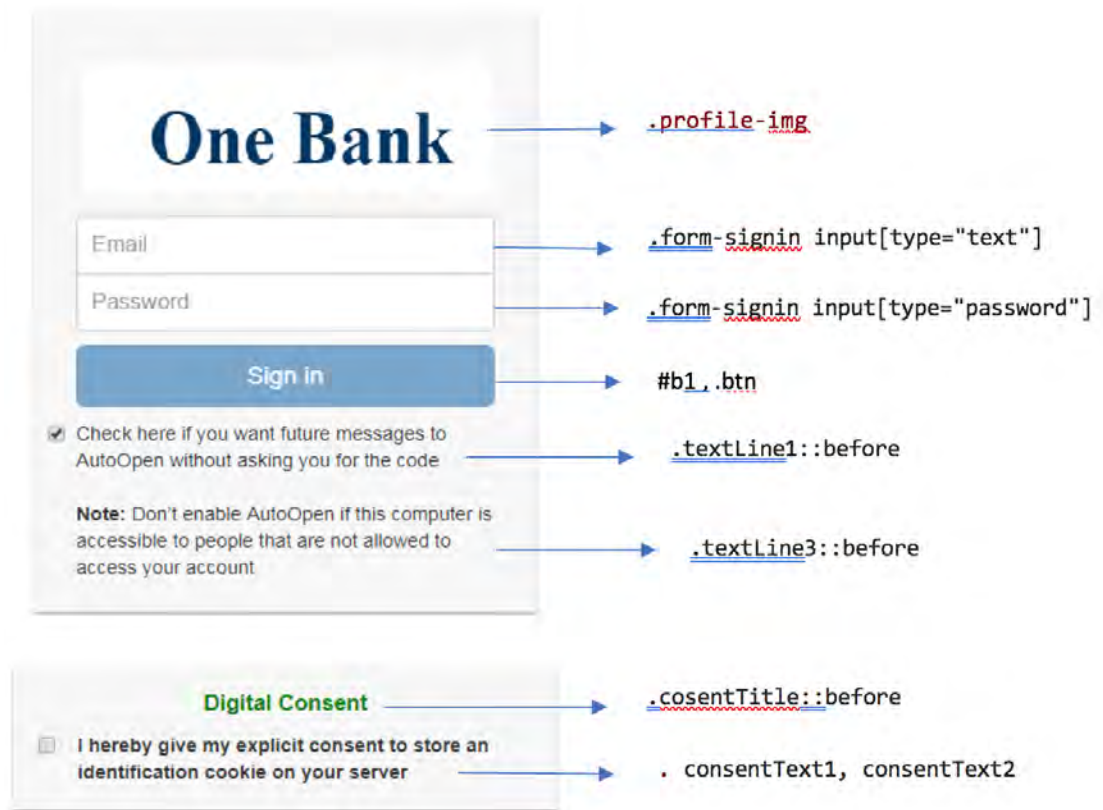
1. The user will need to get the default CSS file for the authentication page. This file is supplied with this technote and can be downloaded directly from the system's file system:

The file name is Style.css and it is located under folder:

<INSTALL_DIR>ActivePath\Columba\Web\Columba.Web.Public\styles

2. The user can customize the CSS according to the description below. Note: When replacing the logo, the url should be an external url to a 295x99 pixels image to keep

the existing image size.



- In the communication, the user goes to Communication Delivery page, under the section of Authentication Settings. The section display the customization option once the checkbox "Key defined by external source" is selected in Authentication

4. Under Authentication Page Customization:
 - a. Default Style will use the default CSS for the authentication page
 - b. Customized Style allows uploading a custom CSS
 - c. Click Choose File and upload the custom CSS
 - d. Click Preview Page to see how the Authentication Page will look like with the new CSS
 - e. After preview, if not satisfied, you can either upload a new CSS or revert back to the default style by selecting the Default Style checkbox
