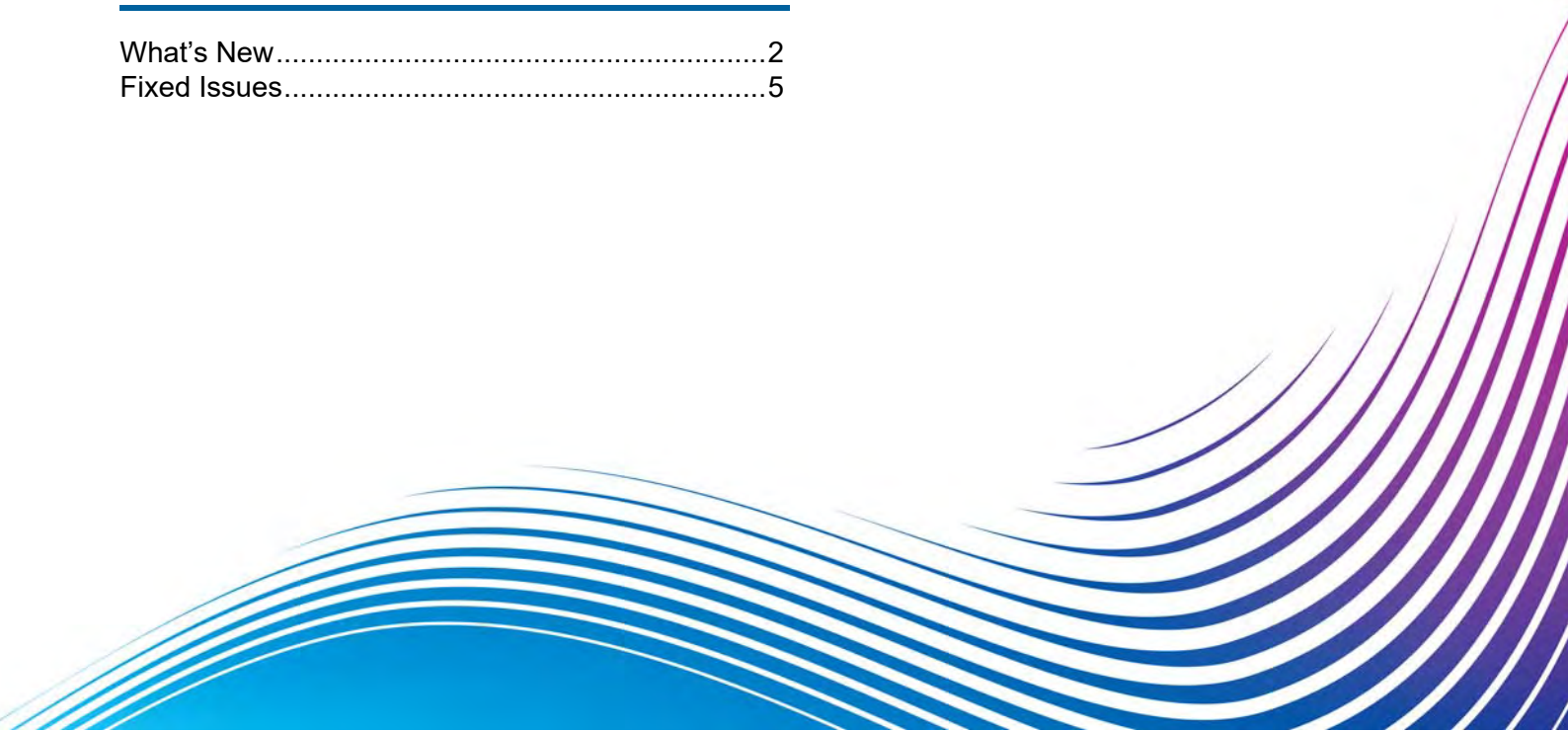

What's New

This release provides support for ConnectRight Mailer and introduces the EngageOne Enrichment Editor as a new licensable option for developing applications using the PDF print stream.

Details of the new and changed tags, functions and system variables are described in the following sections. There are also a number of bug fixes.

Tags

New tags

The following new tags are available:

- `<CRMTIMEOUT>`

Specifies the number of minutes to wait for a ConnectRight Mailer job to finish.

- `<CRMHOTFOLDER>`

Specifies which directory ConnectRight Mailer will monitor when copying the `<FILE>` specified in `<PRESORT>`.

- `<RESOURCEALLOCATION>`

Specifies how to allocate resources during the resource handling process. Standard resource allocation allocates memory, when resources are encountered, and frees duplicate resources. The standard method may result in memory fragmentation and the system may be unable to allocate memory even when memory is available. The defragmented method allocates memory only when resources are known to be unique.

Modified tags

The following tags have been modified:

- `<CASSTYPE>`

To use ConnectRight Mailer to cleanse addresses, specify `<CASSTYPE> C`. This also requires that you use `<PRETYPE> C`.

This release removes the `secondaryType` arguments for the `<CASSTYPE>` tag. The syntax is therefore `<CASSTYPE> type`.

What's New

- `<ONPAGE> B`

The `<ONPAGE>` tag now has a `B[ANNER]` option for adding banner pages specified in a `<BANNER>` tag group. The `B` option applies only to the `<ADD>` group.

- `<PRETYPE> C`

To use ConnectRight Mailer for postal presort, specify `<PRETYPE> C`. This also requires that you use `<CASSTYPE> C`.

Obsolete tags

All the CODE-1 Plus tags are deprecated in this release.

NOTE: For a full list of these tags, see *Obsolete and Retired Tags and System Variables* in the *Language Reference Guide*.

Functions

New functions

The following new functions are introduced in this release:

- `FTP`

This function performs a file transfer of a file to a remote system.

Modified functions

The following functions are modified in this release:

- `STRIP A`

The new `A` argument of the `STRIP` function strips all occurrences of a character from a string.

System Variables

New system variables

The following new system variables are introduced in this release:

- %%PRESORT_RECORD

This new presort system variable is a record of the current document from position 1 of the file specified by <OUTFILE1>. This system variable can only be used in a Rule File, where it is valid in the Presorted and Page Rule File sections.

- %%MSP_IMB

This new presort system variable contains the 65 character TADF Payload returned from MailStream Plus. This system variable can only be used in a Rule File, where it is valid in the Presorted and Page Rule File sections.

Obsolete system variables

The system variables that worked only with CODE-1 Plus are deprecated in this release.

Fixed Issues

This release contains fixes for the following issues:

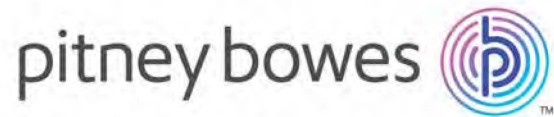
- Use pipes rather than temporary files to prevent conflicts with multiple simultaneous executions, for some MAC address determination.
- Support Australia Post 4 state barcode for PDF.
- Support rectangular DataMatrix barcodes for PDF.
- Fix "Report Field Values" in Visual Engineer for PDF.
